RE: PLAN DEMOLITION OF THE TENDAMBA PRIMARY SCHOOL

We write this letter for and on behalf of our client, the Sokpare family, on whose express instructions this letter is written.

Sir, following the Wa Municipal Assembly's arbitrary decision to demolish the Tendamba Primary School to give way for the construction of the 24-hour economy market amidst objections by our client, the landlords of the area in issue, a writ of summons together with an application for interlocutory injunction have since been filed at the High Court, Wa, challenging the Assembly's decision.

Our client tells us that despite the pending application for interlocutory injunction, which has since been served on the Assembly and which, in law, constitutes a suspension of any activities on the land until it is heard, the Assembly is going ahead with its plans to demolish the school and has since contacted the school authorities to relocate the pupils for the demolition exercise to commence.

Respectfully, this conduct of the Assembly is not only unlawful but also a clear disrespect for the authority of the Court. We are therefore writing this letter to notify you of the possible confrontation this unlawful decision of the Assembly may create, and to request your intervention to advise the Assembly to hold off

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on the said demolition until the pending motion for interlocutory injunction is determined.

Please be informed that our clients are resolute and will employ all lawful self-help measures to ensure that the authority of the Court is not disregarded and/or to prevent the demolition of the school while the motion is pending.
